Checking in for your appointment:

- In order to protect your identity and medical coverage, we will require you to show your photo ID and insurance card at each visit.
- Co-pays and outstanding balances will be collected prior to your visit.

At your appointment:

Please be patient with our staff if the doctor is running behind. And please know that when you are seen, you will be given the same high quality attention by the physician as every other patient regardless of the time it takes.

Prescription request policy:

- If you need a REFILL on medication you have already been prescribed by Dr. Yull, please contact your pharmacy to make the request (even if you have no refills remaining on your current prescription). The pharmacy will call or fax our office with the request. This will help to expedite your request.
- If you need a prescription for a medication you have not been prescribed already, or need to change a medication you already have, please call our office. If you have to leave a message it is important that you leave your first and last name, your date of birth, what medication you need or what problem you are having with the medication you have, and the pharmacy where you want the prescription sent.
- If your medication has to be an actual written prescription we will write that up for you and call you to let you know when to pick it up.
